

Town Hall Cobden Sept 11th 1884

Special Meeting of the Municipal Council held in the town hall Cobden on the above mentioned day the Rev. Mr. McEustill in the chair councillors present Mr. Jamison and Delaney.
 Moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Delaney that the clerk be instructed to write to the Attorney General of the province notifying him of the death of Francis Goslin who died in this township on the 3rd inst. and whose heirs if any is not known, said Goslin leaving on his person \$11.⁵⁴/₁₀₀ and four promissory notes of fifty dollars each also stating the amount of cost the council has been at for the burial of him, and asking information as to what is to be done with said property
