Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the township of Ross Mt in the town hall Cobden, on the above mentioned day the Rev. Mr. McCasbille in the chair Councilors all present Minutes of former meeting read, approved of and signed by the Rev. and clerk. Moved by Mr. McAlister and second by Mr. Humphreys that the road Com. be instructed to examine the bridges on the Queens Line near Isaac Millers & Mt. Murray and that part of the road known as the burned crosslay near Jamisons Line Kill and have the same repaired Carried. Moved by Mr. McAlister and second by Mr. Garrison that the Clerk be instructed to notify John Whalen to remove his fence off the pro of line between 20 & 21 in 5 Con. Carried. Moved by John Delaney second by Mr. Humphreys that the Clerk be instructed to notify J. Luce to remove his rollaway from the bridge at his Mill and to repair the sculling of bridge and have the same done before the 14th November Carried
