

Town Hall, Ludden 2nd May /87

A Special meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Ludden on 2nd Inst. Mr McCaskill, the Reeve in the Chair Councillors all present.

Minutes of previous meeting read & approved & signed by the Reeve.

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr Jamieson that this Council do accept of Donald R. McDonalds offer of a piece of land for a road, being a continuation of the Pembroke Road, eastward, for the sum of sixty dollars & the removing of the fence now along the Concession line to the Southwest side of said piece of land, and also convey to him that part of the Concession line opposite Lot No 6. in the Second Concession line, and that the Road Commissioner employ a surveyor as early as possible and have the same surveyed, & furnish the Council with a plan of same. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by James McWhite that the Road Commissioner, be instructed to post-up notices, forbidding any one, travelling over the Crossley around the head of Muskrat Lake until the water fall below the level of the Road bed, and that he have a fence placed across the road at Mr Luffys Hill. Carried

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr John Ross, that this Council do now adjourn. Carried
