

Town Hall, Leston 21st May 1879

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Leston on the 21st Inst. as a Court of Revision and for the general business of the Township.

The Reeve and all the Councillors present, after taking the necessary oath of Office, each member of the Court took his seat at the Board, The Reeve in the Chair.

Moved by James McAlister & second by John Jamieson that the following changes be made in the Assessment Roll.

- (1) That Thos. J. Elliott's name be struck ~~out~~ off for Village lot No. 9 in the eighth Con. and that the same be assessed to James J. Ritchie
- (2) That Village lots Nos 183 + 184 be struck off Edward Luff's assessment, and that his assessment be lowered twenty five dollars, and that the said lots be added to Francis Repp's assessment, and that it be assessed twenty five dollars. —
- (3) That Geo. Bates be assessed for $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 2, in the 8th Con. in the place of Thos Bates, and that Thos Bates be assessed for the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of ~~lot No. 10, in the 5th Con. 4, + E $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 4 in the 5th Con.~~
- (4) That Robt Reilley be assessed for the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 13, in the 5th Con. and that James Hoyle's name be struck off for the same.
- (5) That John Yuneau be struck off the Roll, + that John Byce be entered in his place.
- (6) That Geo. Hunt be entered as tenant for Lot No. 13, Haley's Station. —

- (7) That $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 4 with 2nd Con. be assessed to Samuel Simpson + Peter C. McKaren instead of Alexander Hudson.
- (8) That Peter Sullivan be entered as tenant for Lot No. 11, in the 10th Con.
- (9) That John G. Grant be entered as farmer's son for ~~the~~ $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 10, in the 12th Con.
- (10) That a reduction of twenty five dollars be made in the assessment of Philander Smith, on Lot No. 24, in the 3rd Con.
- (11) That Frederic Burton's name be struck off for ~~the~~ $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot No. 11 in the first Con. and West $\frac{1}{2}$ of 11, in ~~the~~ the 2nd Con. and that Mr John Lee be assessed for the same. —
also that the assessment of \$100.00 for personal property be taken off. — Carried

Moved by Mr Jamison & seconded by Mr McAlister that the Roll as now revised be ~~now~~ accepted. Carried
Moved by Mr Delahoy, Seconed by John Rose that the Court of Revision Carried
now Close

The Council then adjourned their meeting for the general business of the Township. Mr McAlister in the chair, Councilmen all present. Minutes of previous meeting read & approved - & signed by the Reeve & clerk.

Moved by Mr Jamison & Secd by Mr Delahay that By Law No 27, for the purpose of paying out Certain Sums of Money mentioned therein, be now brought up & read a first-time. Carried
By Law No 27 was brought up & read a first time accordingly -

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by Mr McAlister that an order be granted on the Treasurer, in favor of John Barton & P. R. Ponder for the sum of three dollars each, for auditing the Treasurers Books. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by Mr McAlister that an order be granted on the Treasurer in favor of R. Allen for the sum of six 50/100 dollars being amount paid by him for work on roads near Wefus & the John's Burn. Also the sum of ten 50/100 dollars premium on insurance of Town Hall. - Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & Secd by Mr Delahay that an order be granted on the Treasurer in favor of R. C. Miller, for the sum of fifteen 25/100 dollars, for printing, as per Bill. Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & Secd by Mr Rose that an order be granted on the Treasurer in favor of Mr Grant for the sum of six 75/100 dollars, being amt paid by him for plants, as per acf presented. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delahay & Secd by Mr Jamison that the petition of Dennis Gorman & others to close the public Road, across lots 23 & 24 in the Sixth Concession, be left over till the meeting of Council in October.

Carried

Moved by Mrs Jamison seconded by
Mr McAlister that an order be granted
on the Treasurer in favor of Owen McKay for the
sum of Seventeen Dollars for the tax of
this Township. Carried

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by Mr Jamison
that the Road Com be instructed to examine
the crossing line between Mrs McGeo and
Henry Elliotts, and the fourth ~~line~~ Concession
line between Henry Elliotts & Henry Hills & report
necessary repairs at next meeting
of Council. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamison & seconded by Mr
McAlister that the Road Commissioners be
instructed to examine the road near
Mr Gormans on Con. line between Range
5 & 6, opposite lots 22 & 23, & report
necessary repairs at next meeting of Council.
Carried

Moved by Mr Rose & seconded by Mr Delahay
that By Law No. 27 be brought & read & second,
& third time short & passed.
Carried

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by
Mr McAlister that this Council do now
adjourn to meet again on the second
Saturday in June. Carried
