

Town Hall, Cobden 11th June 1887

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township Ross, met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the 11th Inst, for the purpose of general business of the Township. Mr McLeister, the Reeve in the Chair. Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read & approved and signed by the Reeve & Clerk.

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr Ross, that the Reeve take legal advice as to what action shall be taken regarding money & notes, now in the hand of the Township Treasurer, which was found on the person of one Goolin, who died at Mrs Bulmer last summer.

Moved by Mr DeLaney & seconded by Mr Jamieson that we front the sum of forty dollars to be expended in purchasing lumber, for repairing the Plank Walks in Cobden, the Pathmaster to have the same repaired by Statute Labor. And that the portion east of Crawford St. be fixed & repaired & extended to the East Corner of Dr. Pettray

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr McLeister that the Reeve & Treasurer be authorized and are hereby authorized to borrow by way of loan the sum of three hundred & fifty dollars to defray the expense of repairing roads &c

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr Rose that the Road Commissioners be authorized to expend the sum of fifty dollars on the Gorman Line, & the sum of twenty dollars on the 4th Concession line between Henry Elliotts & John Mc Culbrens

Moved by Mr Jamison & seconded by Mr McAllister that the Road Commissioners have the bridge on the four Road near my own Mc Harons repaired & said repairs not to exceed the sum of ten dollars

Moved by Mr Jamison & seconded by John Rose that the Reeve & Clerk be authorized and are hereby authorized to warrant orders on the Treasurer for the amounts of the accounts for the wages of the men now employed by the Road Commissioners making the road lately purchased from Dr R McDonald & the Pembroke Road on presentation of their true accounts duly receipted

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr McAllister that the Communication of Edward Luffy Secy treas of S.S. No. 10. be left over till the next meeting of Council.

Moved by Mr Rose & led by Mr Jamison that the Pathmasters Chris Crozier & Joseph Wall, be and are hereby authorized when part of the Road work performed on the line between 1st Con. & Town line near Francis's place

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr McAllister that this Council do now adjourn, to meet again in first date in Aug. at 10 o'clock A.M.
