

Town Hall, Cobden, 6th Aug 1887

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, on the above mentioned date, for the transaction of the general business of the Township, Mr McLeskill the Reeve in the Chair, Councillors all present, Minutes of previous meeting read and approved of & signed by the Reeve & Clerk.

Mr Jamieson gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of levying and collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Township for the ensuing year.

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr Rose & resolved, That Whereas a Certified Copy of a Resolution of Westmeath Council, has been presented by Messrs Stewart & Smith, offering to assist the Township of Ross, Bromley & Stafford in having the McAllister Dam on the Town Land, Pembroke & Stafford lowered, and Whereas owing to the amount of public & private property seriously injured within this municipality, by recent improvements on said dam, rendering it necessary, that some action be taken in the matter,

Be it therefore Resolved that the Reeve be and he is hereby appointed a delegate & we further recommend, that delegates be appointed by the respective Municipalities interested to meet & confer with the delegate so appointed by us, at what time and



place they may determine, to prepare a basis of action for said municipalities which will be subject to approval of the several Councils interested. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr McAlister that By Law No. 29, for the purpose of Levying & collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Township for the ensuing year, be now brought up & read a first time. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr McAlister, that By Law No. 29, for the purpose of Levying & collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Township for the ensuing year, be now brought up & read a second and third time short & passed, and that the blanks be filled up with the sum of four mills on the dollar for Township purposes, and five mills on the \$ for County Rates, on all rateable property in this Municipality. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson & seconded by Mr McAlister that the Petitions of Edward Gibson & other, James News & others, regarding Arsenic & Water Caines, be left over till next meeting of Council and that a lawyers advice be taken on the same. And that the Name be & he is hereby authorized to get the said advice - Carried

Moved by Mr Rose & seconded by Mr Jamieson that the Bills of David Ross & Rich. & Bleasell, be left over till next meeting of Council. Carried
