A regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross, was held in the Town Hall held on, on the 14th Oct. for the ^{transaction of the} general business of the Township. Mr Geo. McLean held the Chair. Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved & signed by the Dean & Clerk. —

Mr Delaney gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money mentioned therein. —

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr McAllister, that the Road Comrs have the Bridge at the Appleby repaired. Amount not to exceed six dollars. Carried.

Moved by Mr McAllister & seconded by Mr Rose, that the Road Commissioners inspect the bridges near James Pattinson's and have the same repaired. Carried.

Mr Dennis Gorman, John Gorman and George Dillabough made an offer that they would give an allowance of 40 feet, along the side line of their farms, from the Queens Line to the 4th Con, and to connect same with present road to Haley's Station, on condition that this Council do close up the present forced Road, known as the Bay Road.

It was then moved by Mr Rose, seconded by Mr McAllister that this Council do accept of their offer, & agree to close up the present Road, & then they open up the proposed line & have it suitable for public travel. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by
Mr Rose, that we grant the sum of
fifteen dollars, towards improving the Town
Line between Ross & Bromley from Lot No.
7 South towards Alberto Amsted's Corner
the Township of Bromley having granted
an equal amount. Carried -

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by
Mr Rose that By Law No. 30, for the purpose
of paying out of certain Sums of Money
mentioned therein be now brought-up &
read a first-time Carried -

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded
by Mr Delahay that By Law No. 30, be now
brought-up & read a second & third time
short & passed, Carried -

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded
by Mr Rose that this Council do
now adjourn to meet again on the
third Saturday in December.
