

Town Hall, Cobden
5th May 1888.

Pursuant to adjournment, the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the 5th May 1888, as a Court of Revision and for the general business of the Township. The Reeve and all the Councillors present. After taking the necessary oath of Office, each member took his seat at the Board. The Reeve Mr McCookill in the Chair. —

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr Rose, that the following changes be made in the Assessment-Roll.

- 1st That the Assessment of Stephen Ryer be reduced two hundred dollars.
- 2nd That the Name of Mr Leacy be struck off the Roll, for Lot No. 377 in the Village of Cobden, and that R. W. Crawford's Name be entered for the same.
- 3rd That the Name of James Mundsack jr. be struck off the Roll, for Lot No. No. 12, in the 9th Con. and that the Name of Edward Bulmer be entered for same. and that the Assessment of \$100. for Personal Property be struck off, and that the Assessment be reduced that amount.
- 4th And that Lots Nos 10, 11, 12, 13, in the Village of Foxsters Falls, now on the Non-Resident Roll, be put on the Resident Roll, and assessed to Mrs Charles Milles.
- 5th That the Name of Mr. A. G. Robertson be entered on the Assessment Roll, for Village No. 65, Cobden, as occupant, and the sum of two hundred dollars be entered for same. —

Moved by Mr. Delaney & seconded by Mr. McAlister, that By Law No. 37, for the purpose of appointing a "Local Board of Health," be now brought up and read a third time short & passed. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Delaney & seconded by Mr. Jamison that the levee near the bridge across Coffey's Creek, be repaired. Carried.

by Mr Jamieson, That George Ross, be allowed
to perform his ^{statutory} labor on the Com. line, between
Range Nos 5 & 6, opposite Nos 9 & 10.
