on the 4th August, 1888, for the transaction
of the general business of the Township.
Mr Delahoy took the Chair, the

Minutes of previous meeting read
and approved of and signed by
the Chairman and Clerk.

the Chair.

Moved by Mr Delahoy and seconded by
Mr Jamieson. That By Law No 40 for the purpose
of raising by way of loan the sum of one thousand
dollars for School Section No. 10, be now
brought up and read a first time, Carried.

Mr Jamieson gives notice that he will at
this present sitting of Council introduce
a By Law for the purpose of altering
the limits of polling subdivisions No. 1 & 2.

Mr. Delaney gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law, for the purpose of levying and collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Township for the ~~present~~ ensuing year.

Moved by Mr. Delaney & seconded by Mr. Jamieson that By Law No. 40, for the purpose of raising by way of loan the sum of one thousand dollars for School Section No. 10. be now brought up and read a second and third time that and passed. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson & seconded by Mr. Rose that the Clerk notify the warden of the County, that the Government Road between the Ross & Horton Town Line, and Bolton is now impassable, and as said Road is the main Road through the County, and leads to the Postage on Foot Bridge, being the only Bridge between this County and the County of Pontiac Request him (the warden) to have the County Council take action to either repair or cause the Township of Horton to repair and make passable the said Road, Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson and seconded by Mr. McAllister that the Clerk notify the Postmaster to have the fences or any obstructions removed off the Road on the Fifth Concession line near Francis Neils, on or before the 1st October 85. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson & seconded by Mr. Rose that By Law No. 42 for the purpose of altering the limits of Polling Subdivisions Nos 1 & 2, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and seconded
by Mr Jamieson, That the Clerk have the
proper notice published That the Municipal
Council of this Municipality will pass a
By Law, at its next meeting, which meeting takes
place on the last Saturday in October, to close
up that part of the Road known as "Goulds Line"
which crosses the Wth of Lot No. 12, in the 2nd Con.
Deeding the same to James Bucklebone in
Lieu of a Road allowance across the said
James Bucklebone's Land, from Goulds Line to
1st Con. Line between Lots No. 12 & 13.
The same to be included by him to this Municipality
Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and seconded
by Mr McAlister, That By Law, No. 41, for the
purpose of levying & collecting a sufficient
sum of money to defray the expenses of
the current year, be now brought up and read
a first time, Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose seconded by Mr
McAlister That By Law No. 42, for the purpose
of altering the limits of polling subdivisions Nos
one & two, be now brought up and read a second
and third time shot and passed. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and seconded by Rose
That an order be granted on the Treasurer
in favor of Richard Blackwell for the sum
of twelve dollars in payment of job done
on 1st Concession, Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney & seconded by Mr Jamieson
That By Law No. 41, for the purpose of levying & collecting
a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary
expenses of the current year be now brought up and read
a second & third time shot & passed, & that the blanks
be filled up with 2 mills on the dollar for Townships

purposes and 5 mills on the dollar for County
purposes.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson & seconded by
Mr. McAlister, That as the licenses to the Tavern keepers
were not issued for nearly two months, after
the beginning of the license year, That this
Council do make a rebate of thirty dollars
to each of the holders of a Tavern license,
Carried.
