for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Rev. Mr. McEaskill in the Chair, Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved of and signed by the Rev. and Clerk.

Mr. Delaney gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr. Delaney and seconded by Mr. Jamieson that By Law No. 43 for the purpose of paying out certain sum of money be now brought up and read a first time.

By Law No. 43 was read a first time.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson and seconded by Mr. James McAlister, "That Robert Reilly and John H. Reynolds, he & she are hereby given the privilege of using that portion of the concession line between Ranges six & seven, opposite their lots Nos 3 and 4. until such time as this Municipality requires it for road purposes and on the condition that they shall remove all fences and give peaceable possession of said Con. to this Corporation when required so to do. as they had given the government ^{road} free access said lots. carried.

On Motion of Mr Delahay Secounded
by Mr Rose, ^{That} By Law No. 44, for
the purpose of closing up that part of
Road known as Gaults Line. Crossing
the west half of lot No. twelve in the 2nd
Concession was now brought up and
read a first time.

On Motion of Mr Jamison
Secounded by Mr Rose, By Law No. 44
for the purpose of closing up a certain
portion of Road described therein, was
now brought up and read a second &
third time short and passed.

Moved by Mr Delahay Secounded by
Mr Jamison "That by Law No. 43,
for the purpose of paying out certain
sums of money mentioned therein
be now brought up and read a second
and third time short and passed. carried

Moved by Mr Delahay and Secounded by
Mr Jamison, That the Reeve and Treasurer
be authorized to borrow by way of loan
from John Cattman & Co, a sum of
money sufficient to meet payments
for the rebuilding of the Forsters Falls
Bridge. and give notes payable 1st Jan 190

Moved by Mr McAlister and Secounded
by Mr Rose, That Mr Jamison be
authorized to give out the contract
for Building Morrisons Bridge to
James Brown for the sum of thirty
four dollars.

Moved by Mr McAlister, seconded by Mr Rose, That this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the second Saturday in December. Carried.
