

Town Hall, Cobden

28th Feb, 1889.

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

The Reeve being absent Mr Delaney, Deputy-Reeve, took the Chair. Councillors all present.

The minutes of the previous was now read and confirmed, and signed by the Deputy Reeve.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr Rose, "That an order be granted in favor of Mr Howie, Collector, for the sum of five $\frac{90}{100}$ dollars, being taxes charged against the Methodist parsonage, Cobden, and also for the sum of three dollars for Road work, charged against the Township and performed by him as per letter of Postmaster.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr McAlister "That the time for the return of the Collectors Roll be extended until the last day of March.

Carried.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this meeting of Council introduce a By Law to fix the duties payable for Tavern and Shop Licenses in the Township of Ross.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr McAlister, "That By Law 49, for the purpose of fixing the duties payable for Tavern and Shop Licenses in the Township of Ross, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose and seconded by Mr McAlister "That By Law No. 49, be now brought up and read a second time and the blanks be filled in with one hundred and forty dollars" Carried

Moved by Mr Rose and seconded by Mr Bulmer "That By Law No. 49, be now brought up and read a third time short and passed" Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr Rose "That this Council do now adjourn to meet again on Saturday the 4th May next, as a Court of Revision and afterwards for general business." Carried.
