Moved by Mr Edward Bulmer & seconded by Mr Jim Rose, "That Lots 246 & 247 in the village of Cobden, now assessed to Allan McHat, be assessed to Mr Deacon, as owner." Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Bulmer "That the Assessment of Mr Appleby be ~~500~~ ~~the~~ Assessed, stating that he assessed him for that amount, and entered \$357^{xx} in error - Carried

A petition was now presented by Mr Hamilton signed by a large number of the Rate payers of the Village of Cobden, praying that the Council grant a sum of Money for the purpose of extending the plank walk, from the terminus of present plank walk, opposite Dr Ruttrays, to the Pembroke Road or Town Hall. The said Rate payers offering to furnish Cedar sleepers, and lay the plank free of charge. It was then moved by Mr DeLaney and seconded by Mr McAlister that we grant the sum of forty dollars, to be expended in buying plank to extend the present walk to the Town Hall, and that Mr Tho. Burton purchase the plank and see that the plank walk is properly laid Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and seconded by Mr Bulmer. That we do grant the sum of seven dollars to purchase plank for water course across road at Foresters Falls and that the Pathmaster purchase the same. Carried.
