

Town Hall, Coburn
31st August/89

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Coburn on the 31st August/89, for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Deputy Reeve in the Chair, the Reeve being absent. Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved of and signed.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a by-law, for the purpose of levying and collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the expenses of this Municipality for the current year, and also the County Rates and equivalent to Legislation grants to Public Schools.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr Rose, that the Council do adjourn for one hour. carried

Council resumes business at one o'clock P.M. The Reeve being present took the Chair.

Moved by Mr DeLokey and seconded by Mr Bulmer, That By Law 53 for the purpose of levying and collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the expenses of the Municipality and also for the County Rates, and equivalent to Legislation grant to Public Schools for the current year be now brought up and read a first time. carried

Moved by Mr Delaney & Seconded by Mr Bulmer. That By Law No. 53, for the purpose of laying and collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Municipality, and also for the County Rate and Equivalent to Legislative grant to Public Schools for the Current year, be now brought up and read a second time, and that the blanks be filled up with the sum of four mills on the dollar for Municipal purposes, and six mills on the dollar for County Rate, and equivalent to Legislative grant for Public Schools. - Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and Seconded by Mr Bulmer. That By Law No. 53 for the purpose of Laying and Collecting a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the Municipality for the Current year, and also for the County Rate and equivalent to Legislative grant to Public Schools be now brought up and read a third time short & passed. - Carried.

Moved by Mr Delaney and Seconded by Mr McAlister That the Members of this Council do examine the Bridges across Coffey's Creek on Proving Line, and the Bridge at McLaughlin's, on the 8th Con. Line. and the Bridge across Roaches Creek on Goulds Line. on Monday 23rd Sept. and have the same, built or repaired as required. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose and Seconded by Mr McAlister. That this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the last Saturday in October 1889. Carried.
