

Town Hall, Cobden
28th Dec. 1889

The municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall on the above date, for the transaction of the general business of the Township. Mr McAlister in the Chair. Messrs Rose Bulmer & McAlister being present.

Minutes of previous meeting was now read and approved of and signed by the Chairman and Clerk.

The Deputy Reeve being now present took the Chair.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr McAlister that By Law No. 55, for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

On motion of Mr Rose seconded by Mr McAlister, the Council adjourned for one hour.

Afternoon Session, Some members present with the addition of the Reeve who now took the Chair.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Rose that this Council do grant the sum of ten dollars for the repairing Culverts on Lower Line between Ross & Bromley. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Babner & seconded by Mr. McAlister, that John Gardner be given an order on the Treas for the sum of thirty dollars for repairing bridge on Coffey's Creek. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Rose and seconded by Mr. McAlister, that by Law No. 55, for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money, be now brought up and read a second time and the blanks filled up with the following amounts mentioned therein and then read a third time short and passed. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Babner and seconded by Mr. McAlister that the following accounts be paid. Mr. McMillan twenty dollars for building bridge at the head of Gibson Lake.

L. D. Edmunds, sixteen dollars for repairing bridge on Garden Road.

D. Brown six dollars & sixteen cents, plank for Culberts, on Gov. Road Forster's Falls.

John Howie, seven $\frac{13}{100}$ dollars being taxes against lots 25 & 26 Forster's Falls, property of the Presbyterian Church, and exempt from taxes.

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by Mr Bulmer, that By Law No. 56. for the purpose of appointing N. R. Officers for the three polling subdivisions, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Rose that By Law No. 56. for the purpose of appointing N. R. Officers for the polling subdivisions be now brought up and read a second time and the blanks filled in with the names of Mr Grant, John Howe and John McGinn. Carried

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Rose that By Law No. 56. be now brought up and read a third time short and passed. Carried.

Moved by Mr Delahay & seconded by Mr McAlister that the Council do now adjourn sine die.
