

Town Hall, Cobden
7th June 1890.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, on the above date, as a Court of Revision. After taking the necessary oath, each member took his seat at the board, the Reeve, Mr. DeLaney, in the Chair.

Moved by Mr. McAllister and seconded by Mr. Palmer that the following changes be made in the Assessment Roll, by this Court:

- (1) That Lot No. 166, be taken off the Assessment of S. R. Halpenny and the same be assessed to David Humphries.
- (2) That Lot No. 58, be assessed to S. R. Halpenny and that the name of Henry Hawkins, be struck off.
- (3) That the name of Henry Hawkins be entered, ^{as} tenant for Lot No. 153.
- (4) That the name of Mrs Lee be struck off for Lot No. 359. and that the said Lot be assessed to Alexander Bell.
- (5) That Village Lot-375, be struck off Thos. Burton's Assessment, and that his assessment be reduced one hundred dollars and that the said Lot-375, be assessed to J. M. Ritchie at \$100 =
- (6) That Lot No. 8 1/2 of Min of 1, in the 5. Con. be taken off the Assessment of P. R. Pomeroy and that his assessment be reduced \$200. = as said Lot was assessed to Geo. Barry, and that said amount be deducted from Assessment Roll.

- (7) That Daniel Woods be assessed for T. L. 495, known as Blank lot, in the village of Cobden, at \$100.=- and that the same be struck off the assessment of Mrs. Burton, and that the said Mrs. Burton's assessment be lowered \$100.=-
- (8) That James Armstrong be entered on Roll as Tenant for Lots No. 27, 28 & 29

Moved by Mr. McAlister and seconded by Mr. Bulmer, that the Roll as now Revised be accepted. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & seconded by Mr. McAlister, that the Court of Revision do now adjourn. Carried.

The Council now opened their meeting for the general business of the Township, the Reeve, in the Chair, Councillors, Messrs McAlister, Bulmer, & Rose present, minutes of previous meeting read and approved, and signed.

Moved by Mr. Rose and seconded by Mr. McAlister, that the Clerk do give to Francis Guest, a certified Copy of the By Law passed by the Council granting to him that part of property line opposite lot no. 16 in the First Con. of Ross in lieu of land deeded by him to the Council for road purposes on the opposite side of lot.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & seconded by Mr. Rose, that Mrs. Ross be appointed Pathmaster in the place of James Jessup deceased. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr McAlister, That the Council do adjourn for one hour. Carried.

Pursuant to adjournment, same members present.

Moved by Mr Rose and seconded by Mr McAlister That the sum of twenty five (\$25.00) be granted to repair and open up the Tonn line, between Ross & Westmeath from the Cobden & Pembroke Road towards Down line, between Ross & Bromley, being equal to amount granted for same purpose by the Westmeath Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & sec'd by Mr Rose That Mr Bulmer be authorized to inspect the foot Road at Mrs Wharens and if required have the same ditched at an expense of not more than \$15.00 Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr McAlister That we grant the sum of fifteen dollars towards repairing Bridge between John Wharens & Boltons, foot Road. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr McAlister That we grant the sum of twenty dollars towards purchasing plank, for repairing sidewalk at Foresters Falls. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr Rose That the petition of Mrs Appleby & others be left over until the August meeting of Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & Seconded by Mr McAlister That Michael Nevil be allowed his Statute Labor to open up ditch near his residence. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & seconded by Mr McAlister That the Reeve purchase four steel scrapers, from the Wilkison Plow Co. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr Rose That the sum of \$20.00 be granted to open up the 1st Con. Line from Mr Goulds lot to proving line between Lots 20 & 21. Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Rose That Mr Bulmer have the covering of Bridge at Star Borne's repaired. Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Bulmer That Mr Burton be instructed to procure plank for Culvert, and have the same built and put in between Mr Hudson Hotel, & R.R. Station. Hole to be filled up by Statute Labor. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr McAlister That an order be granted on the Treasurer in favor of Isadora Carron for the sum of two dollars for work done on roads. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & sec'd by Mr Bulmer That an order of \$3.00 be granted on Treas in favor of Robert Guest for repairing roads. Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & second by Mr McAlister
 that an order of three dollars be granted on
 the Treas in favor of Michael Roach for
 repairing roads. Carried -

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded
 by Mr Bulmer that this Council do
 now adjourn to meet again on the
 first Saturday in August, Carried.
