 the Proving Line, between Lots 15 & 16,
 and that Mr McAlister & Mr Bulmer
 have the same expended. Carried.

Mr. Bulmer gives notice, that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a By Law, for the purpose of Levying & Collecting, a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses ^{of this Municipality} for the current year; also the County Rate equivalent to Legislative Grants to public schools and also the amount required by the Trustees of the several School Sections in the Township for School purposes.
