that Mr Delaney be appointed to meet the
gentlemen appointed by the Township of Bromley
and examine the road through Mr James Walls'
farm, and if this Township is liable to any damage
to settle the same. - carried.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at next
meeting of Council introduce a By law for
the purpose of closing up that part of the Old
Govt Road between The Cow's Corner and
Mr McLaughlin's, and that the Clerk be
instructed to have the proper notices pub-
lished. - carried.
