

Town Hall, Cobden
29th August 1891

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Reeve in the Chair, Councillors ^{all present} with the exception of the Deputy Reeve, minutes of previous meeting read and approved, and signed, Mr Bell gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money.

Mr Medlister gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of levying a sufficient Rate out the dollar on all rateable property in the Township, to defray the necessary expenses of the Township, for the current year, also the County Rates the equivalent to Legislation grants to Public Schools, the amount required by Law under the Public School Act, of Ont. 1891, Chap. 52, Sec. 109, and the amounts required by the Trustees of the several School Sections of this Municipality. —

Moved by Mr Bell, and seconded by Mr Rose, That By Law No 72, for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money be now brought up and read a first time.

By Law No. 72 was read a first time accordingly. —

Moved by Mr McAlister and seconded by Mr Bell. That By Law No. 73, for the purpose of Levying, ^{& collecting} a Sufficient Rate on the dollar, on all Rateable property in the Township, to defray the necessary expenses of the Township for the Current year, also the County Rates, the equivalent to the legislative grants to Public Schools. The amount required by Law, under the Public School act. of 1891, Chap. 54, Sect. 109, and also the amounts required by the Trustees of the several School sections of the Township for School purposes, be now brought up and read a first time. — Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister and seconded by Mr Bell That By Law No. 73. be now filled in with the following, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills in $\frac{1}{100}$ for Township purposes and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills in $\frac{1}{100}$ for County Rates, and with 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills in the dollar, for Schools as per act. Chap. 54, Sect. 109. And that it be now brought up and read a second time. Carried

On motion of Mr McAlister Secd by Mr Rose By Law No. 73, was read a third time short and passed.

Moved by Mr Rose, seconded by Mr Bell, That By Law No. 72. be now brought up and read a second time. Carried.

On motion of Mr Bell seconded by Mr Rose By Law No. 72 was read a third time short and passed.

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr Bell, That an order be granted on Treas in favor of J. H. Burton for six dollars, being amount expended on Statute labor in building sidewalk in Lebanon. — Carried

Moved by Mr Rose second by Mr Bell That the
sum of five dollars be granted to S. R. Halpenny
to put in a box drain of 2 inch plank, along Crawford
Street, to get from mouth of drain on main street
said work to be under the supervision of Road
Commissioner, drain to be well made and
properly covered with earth. — Carried.

Moved by Mr McAlister & seconded by Mr
Bell, That the Road Commissioner be in-
structed to have a Culvert put across
the ^{old} Road at ^{new} Brick yard Forsters Falls and
that Mr Riley Patmore, have the ditch
opened, to carry the water to creek, the
said work to be done by Statute Labor, allowing
the parties the work on next years Labor.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Bell and seconded by
Mr Rose, That this Council do now
adjourn to meet again on 31st day of
October, 1891.

The Council now adjourned
according to Resolution.
