

Town Hall, Cobden
26th March 1892

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Reeve in the Chair. Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and confirmed.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law for the paying out of certain sums of money.

Mr Rose gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law for the purpose of Repealing the tax on dogs.

Moved by Mr Bulmer and seconded by Mr McLaren that By Law No. 79 for the paying out of certain sums of money be now brought up and read a first time.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose and seconded by Mr Bell that By Law No. 80 for the purpose of repealing the tax on dogs in this Municipality be now brought up and read a first time.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Rose & seconded by Mr Bell that By Law No. 80 be now brought up and read a second time.

Carried.

On motion of Mr McLaren seconded by Mr Bulmer. By Law No. 80 was read a third time short & passed.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr Bell, that ~~by~~ \$1.64 be refunded to Mrs. Lalonde being amount overcharged on his taxes, and that an order be granted in his favor on the Treasurer for the same.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & seconded by Mr McHaren that an order be granted on Treas in favor of Mrs Elliott Collector for Museum of Seven ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars being \$2.⁰⁰ charged against D. Woods for Road work & certified as performed by Postmaster. \$1.⁰⁰ for dog tax against James McWade, charged in error \$3.⁰⁰ to Joseph Warren exemption of Saw mill property. \$4.⁰⁰ Postage & Stationery for Collector.

Carried.

Moved by Mr Bell & seconded by Mr Rose, that an order be granted on Treas in favor of Matthew Nason ^{for \$1.75} being dog tax charged in error.

Carried.

Mr Bell gives notice that he will at the next meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of closing up the forced Road through Lot No. 6. Cont. 1. known as the Patterson Road, from where it leaves the first rock west of the Railway line to the Town line between Ross & Bromley and that the proper notice be published in the Pembroke Standard.

Carried.

Moved by Mr McHaren & seconded by Mr Bell that orders be granted on the Treas for the following amounts.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & seconded by
Mr. Rose that the Clerk communicate
with the Westmeath Council, with the view
of having the Town Line, between Ross &
Westmeath from Muskpat Lake to the Bromley
Line surveyed, under instructions from the
Lieutenant-Governor in Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & seconded by Mr. Bell,
that the Collector's Roll, be now accepted
Mr. Elliott collector, having collected & paid
to the Treas, the amount of Roll in full. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer, & seconded by Mr. Rose
that James Gilmer be appointed Park Master,
in place of David Thompson, deceased, and
that Geo. Pettigrew Sr. be appointed in place of
John Pettigrew, removed, & that ~~David Gilmer~~
be appointed Parkmaster, to work on 2nd Proving
Line, between 3rd & 5th Cons. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. Rose
that the Petition of James Blackwell & others
asking grant of money to improve the 3rd
Proving line, be left over, until next meet-
ing of Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & seconded by Mr. Bell,
that this Council do grant the sum of
forty dollars to repair & improve the Town
Line, between Ross & Westmeath opposite
the 7 & 8th Cons of Ross, on condition that
the Westmeath Council do make an
equal grant for same purpose. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Babner & seconded by Mr. McLaren that By Law No. 79 be filled in with the amounts as granted by Council and then brought up and read a second time. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Babner seconded by Mr. McLaren By Law No. 79 was read a third time that - and passed. -

Moved by Mr. McLaren & Secd by Mr. Ross that the Road Comr notify E. Guman to remove his fence off the Prory Line. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell, & seconded by Mr. Babner that the Clerk be instructed to purchase 4 Steel Road Scrapers. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Babner seconded by Mr. Ross the Council adjourned till the last Sat. in May, and will meet then as a Court of Revision and afterwards for General Business.
