

Town Hall, Cobden  
2nd July 1892

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, on the above date for the transaction of the General Business of the Township the Reeve in the Chair Councillors all present with the exception of Mr Bulmer.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Mr Bell gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr Bell & Sec'd by Mr McLaren. That By Law No. 83 for the payment of moneys be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Mr Thor Hill presented a petition signed by several Ratepayers asking for a grant of money to fix Bridges and repair road on the 3rd Con. Line from J. Burtons to H. Elliotts.

Moved by Mr Rose & seconded by Mr McLaren, that the sum of twenty five dollars be granted to repair the Bridges & road on 3rd Con. Line from Proving Line at James Burtons towards Henry Elliotts. Carried.

On motion of Mr Bell seconded by Mr Rose no action was taken on the petition of James Wark, which was left over from last meeting of Council.

Moved by Mr Bell & seconded by Mr. Rose  
That Mr. Wm. Prover, be given the job  
of fixing hill on Proving line near John Logans  
at his offer of \$2.50 carried.

Moved by Mr Bell & seconded by Mr. McHaren  
That the Road Commission be instructed  
to give out the contract of building a  
Bridge across the Creek, at Mr. Hank Neil's  
on 3<sup>rd</sup> Con. line. Work to be completed  
on or before the Spring of 1893. carried.

Mr. McHaren gives notice that he will  
at this present meeting, introduce  
a By Law for the purpose of pro-  
hibiting Steers of two years old & upward,  
from running at large, on the Highways  
of this Municipality.

Moved by Mr. McHaren & seconded by  
Mr. Rose, That By Law No. 84, for  
the purpose of prohibiting Steers of two  
years old & upward, from running  
at large on the Highways of this Municipality,  
be now brought up and read a  
first time. carried.

On motion of Mr. McHaren seconded  
by Mr. Rose By Law No. 84, was  
brought up and read a second &  
third time and passed.

Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. McHaren  
That the Road Com<sup>n</sup> be instructed to have  
a ditch dug along the 2<sup>nd</sup> Proving line  
from the Laurel Hill near James Ferguson, to connect  
with the ditch near the 5<sup>th</sup> Con. line. Cost not to exceed  
\$150. carried.

Moved by Mr Bell & second by Mr McLauren  
 That orders be granted on the Treasurer  
 in favor of the following parties for  
 the amounts set opposite each respectively.

 resolution of Council, and then  
 read a second time. Carried

On motion of Mr Bell seconded by  
 Mr Rose By Law No 83 was now  
 brought up and read a third time  
 short and passed.

Moved by Mr McLauren & second by Mr Rose that the Road  
 Comr be instructed when a bridge or Culvert built  
 at Mrs Lees or Gaults line. Carried.

On motion of Mr McLauren seconded  
 by Mr Bell. Council adjourned till last Saturday  
 in August. 1892.
