The Municipal Council of the Township
of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden
on 29th Oct. 92 for the transaction of the
general business of the Township, The Reeve
in the Chair. Councillors all present.
Minutes of previous meeting read and
confirmed.

Mr Bulmer gives notice that
he will at this present meeting of Council
introduce a By Law for the purpose of
paying out certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr Palmer & Secd by Mr Bell
That by Law No. 84 for the purpose
of paying out certain sums of
money be now brought up and
read a first-time.

By Law No. 84, was read a first-time
accordingly.

Moved by Mr Palmer and
seconded by Mr Rose, That the
Clerk write the Gen. Supt. of the C. P. R.
to have a drain made across the
Railway track, for the purpose of taking
the water off the west-side to the drain
on the east-side of the Road, along Main
Street.

Moved by Mr Palmer & Secd by Mr
Bell, That an order be granted ^{on the inspection} in favor
of M. C. G. Coulter Postmaster for the
sum of Eight $\frac{4}{100}$ dollars, being amt. paid
for plank for drain from McRay's
Hotel to Railway track, and that the sum
be deducted out of amount granted
to drain Main Street, to wit, also
the sum of four dollars, statute labor of
C. P. R. returned undone & performed by
Postmaster, and charged against the C. P. R.
Co.
