After the adjournment of the Court of Revision, the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met for the general business of the Township. The Reeve in the Chair, Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and confirmed. Mr. Bell gave notice that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the payment of money. Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. McHaren that By-Law No. 93 for the payment of money be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Petitions were now read from J. M. McHellen & others asking for repairs on bridge near Alex Hawthorn's ~~land~~ from James Foreland asking to have fence across the 3rd Con. line E. of M. L.

removed, also from James E. Brown & others asking for a grant of \$200. to improve proving line between James Remond's & Mrs. Myranda's Lands, from Henry Hill & others asking a grant of money to repair the 2nd proving line. From Robt. Haley & others, asking that the Ontario Government be asked to have the Town line surveyed between Ross & Westmouth West of Muskat Lake, the present line being disputed from the Merchants of Cobden & Forsters Falls asking that a By Law be passed for the closing of the shops at six o'clock p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, of each week from 1st of May until 30th Sept in each year.

Mr. Bulmer gives notice that he will introduce a By Law to regulate the closing of the different classes of shops, in the village of Cobden, Forsters Falls & Haley Station.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & second by Mr. McHaren that By Law No. 94, to regulate the closing of the different classes of shops in the villages of Cobden, Forsters Falls & Haley be now brought up and read a first time.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & second by Mr. McHaren that the road Com. have the following roads repaired.

13. To Rep. Calverts + Bridge on J.W. Road, between D. McHaren & Town line between Horton + Ross 12.⁰⁰
14. To repair Calvert on avenue opposite Mrs Murdochs

Moved by Mr McHaren & seconded by Mr Rose, that on the petition of Rob. Haley and others this Council hereby instructs the Reeve & Clerk, to take the legal steps required, to have the Ontario Government resurvey the townline between Ross & Westmeash, west of M. L. and that the cost of survey be paid by the Township, and charged to the several parties interested and who have petitioned for said survey provided that the Council of Westmeash take same action & pay an equal share of expenses. We also recommend F. Purvis P. L. S. of Egawill to make the said survey.

to meet again on the last
Saturday in August, next.
