

Town Hall, Cobden
26th Aug. 1893

The Municipal Council of the T.
of Ross met in the Town Hall
at 8 o'clock on the above date for
the transaction of the General
Business of the Township.
The Reeve in the Chair.
Councillors all present.
Minutes of previous meeting
read & confirmed.

Moved by Mr. Rose & seconded by
Mr. Bell, That the Road Com-
be instructed to have a Culvert put
across Main St. Cobden, or
near James Livingstone's Barber Shop
Carried.

Mr. Wharm gives notice that he will
at this present meeting of Council
introduce a By Law for the purpose
of levying a sufficient Rate on
the dollar on all Rateable property
to defray the necessary expenses
for the current-year, also the
County Rate and the Equivalent
to the legislative grants to Public Schools
The amount required by law, under the
Public School Act, of Ont., Chap 624
Sec. 109, and the amount required
by the Trustees of the several School
Sections for school purposes in
this Municipality.

Moved by Mr. Rose & seconded by
Mr. McHaren that the Road Commission
be instructed to put in one or two Culverts
as may be found necessary on the
Hay Road, on John Gorman's lot,
Cost not to exceed \$10⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Carried.

Moved by Mr. Rose & seconded by Mr. McHaren
that the Road Commission be instructed
to inspect the Road Near Francis Guest's
and see if the Hill can be avoided by
changing the Road, and if so to have the
road made if it can be done at a cost
not exceeding \$20⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. Bulmer
that the Road Com^y be instructed to repair
the 3rd Con. line from opposite James Rogers
to opposite Henry Elliott's lot. Said work
not to exceed the sum of \$30⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Carried.

Moved by Mr. McHaren & seconded by Mr. Bulmer
that the Road Com^y be instructed to have
the Hill on Gr. Road, near Peter May's straightened
& cut down, Cost not to exceed \$20⁰⁰/₁₀₀
Carried.

Moved by Mr. McHaren & seconded by Mr. Bulmer
that by Law No. 95. for the purpose of levying & collecting
a sufficient Rate for the same, on all Rateable
property in the Township, to defray the expenses of
the Township for the current year, also the Co. Rate
the equivalent to legislative grants to Public Schools
the amount required by law under the Public
School Act for Schools, also the amount
required by the Trustees of the several School Sections
for school purposes, be now brought up and read
a 2nd time. — Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & Secd by Mr. McHaren, That By Law No. 95. have the blanks filled in as follows, for Township purposes 4 mills in the dollar, for Coy. Rates 6. mills on the dollar General fund for Schools 4 1/2 mills in the dollar. and then brought-up and read a second time, Carried.

On motion of Mr. Bulmer Secd by Mr. Rose, By Law No. 95 was now brought-up and read a third time short & passed.

Mr. Bell gives notice, That he will at this present-meeting of Council introduce a By Law. for the payment of Moneys.

Moved by Mr. Bell & Secd by Mr. Rose That-By Law No. 96. for the payment of Moneys be now brought-up and read a first-time. Carried

On motion of Mr. Bell seconded by Mr. McHaren the Council adjourned to the next Sat. in Oct.
