

Town Hall, Cobden

31st March 1894

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden, 31st March 1894 for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Recd in the Chair Councillors all present. Minutes of previous meeting read and Confirmed.

Mr. Bulmer gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the payment of Moneys.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & Secd by Mr. Bell, That By Law No. 100, for the payment of Moneys be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell, & Secd by Mr. McHaren That the Collectors Roll be accepted, from the Collector, as he has paid into the Treasurer the full amount of said Roll, excepting Defaulters List. Carried.

Mr. Robt. Guest asked the Council to Carry into effect the Motion & By Law passed by the Municipal Council, granting ^{3rd} the Proving Line between lots 15 & 16, in the 2nd Concession in lieu of lands given for road off the South side of his lot.

Moved by Mr. Rose & Secd by Mr. McHaren That The Clerk Notify Mr. Fred. Foss and Mr. Gibson to remove their fences off the Proving Line between lots Nos 15 & 16 in the Second Con- of Ross, the fences to be removed before the 1st May next. and if the said parties refuses or neglects to do so That action in law, be taken to Compell them to do so. Carried.

Mr. Donzo Huckabone presented a petition signed by Chas. Ross & others praying the Council to close that part of Goulds Line which crosses his lot. On Condition that he would make the 1st. Con. Line equally as good as present road, except bridge across gully. Moved by Mr. McWharen & seconded by Mr. Bulmer that no action be taken on the said petition, Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & 2nd by Mr. McWharen that James Blackwell be appointed Postmaster in place of John Logan deceased, and that Robt. A. Williams be appointed in place of Jm. Herron Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer and 2nd by Mr. Rose that the Reeve for Chas. St. Steel Road Scrapers for Township purposes. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McWharen & 2nd by Mr. Bell, that the Treasurer get a statement from the License Inspector, showing in detail the amounts of money collected from Licenses & fines, and this Municipality since the

Repeal of the Scott Act. — carried.

Moved by Mr. Buhner & second by Mr. Bell,
That By-Law No. 103, for the purpose of
paying out certain sums of money, be
faded in as per resolution of Council,
and then brought up and read a second
time. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Rose & second by Mr.
McLaren By-Law No. 103 was now
brought up and read a third time
short & passed.

Moved by Mr. Bell
& second by Mr. McLaren. That the
Council do now adjourn until the
last Saturday in May then to
meet as a Court of Revision and
afterwards for general business,
Carried.
