hills between Ostrander's Lake and Mrs. Paves
amount: not to exceed twenty five dollars.
Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & second by Mr. Rose
that a grant of thirty dollars be given to
repair 4th Con. Line between 3rd Proving
Line & R. J. Provers, and that Mr. Rose
give out the job of same. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell, & second by Mr. Bulmer
that Francis Neil, be allowed two days
Statute Labor for next year for labor per-
formed by him on Proving Line. Carried.
