

Town Hall, Cobden
25th August 1894.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden, on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township. The Deputy Reeve in the Chair.
All the Councillors present. Except the Reeve.
Minutes of previous meeting read and confirmed.

Mr. Ross gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the payment of moneys.

Mr. Bell gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of levying a sufficient Rate on the dollar on all Rateable property in the Town of Ross to defray the necessary expenses for the current year, also the County Rates, and the equivalent to the Legislative grants to public schools. The amount required by Law under the Public School Act, of Ontario, Chap. 57 Sec. 109, and the amount required by the Trustees of the several School Sections for School purposes in this Municipality.

Moved by Mr. Ross. Seconded by Mr. McHaren that By Law No. 104 for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money be now brought up and read a first time, & carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. Ross that By Law No. 106, for the purpose of levying ^{and collecting} a sufficient Rate on the dollar on all Rateable property in the Township to defray the expenses of the Township for the current year, also the County Rates the equivalent to Legislative grants to public schools

Moved by Mr. McLaren & seconded by Mr. Rose that the amount required by Law under the Public School Act. of Ont. Also the amount required by the Trustees of the several school sections for school purposes, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & seconded by Mr. Rose that the sum of twelve dollars be granted to John Ross Postmaster for pulling stumps on Tronny Lane near Mr. Ireland. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Rose and seconded by Mr. Bell that the application of Mrs. A. McNabb be left over till next meeting of Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell & seconded by Mr. Rose that a grant of thirty dollars be given to repair the Road from D. McLaren to Town line of Ross & Horton. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Bell seconded by Mr. McLaren that Mr. J. H. Elliott be appointed Collector for the present year, at a salary of \$400. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLaren, seconded by Mr. Bell, that by Law No. 106. have the blanks filled in as follows. For Spec. purposes 2 1/2 mills in the dollar for Co. Rates 7 1/2 mills in the dollar. General fund for Schools under the "Public School Act of Ont." 4 1/2 mills in the dollar. And then brought up and read a second time. Carried.
