

Town Hall, Cobden
March, 2nd 1895

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden, on the above date, for the transaction of the general business of the Township, the Rev. Mr. Jamieson in the Chair, all the other members present. Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed.

Mr. Reynolds gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the payment of moneys.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & seconded by ^{Mr.} Crozier that the Council do grant the sum of \$25⁰⁰ towards repairing the Town line between this Township & the Township of ^{Horton} ~~Horton~~, opposite the 6th Concession of Ross, provided Horton Township makes an equal grant. and that Mr. Cook, Road Comr. of this Township, cooperate with Road Comr. of Horton and give out the job.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & seconded by Mr. McLaren that By Law No. 113. for the payment of moneys be now brought up and read a first time.

procure Cedars for Culverts on Queen's
Road near Mr. Sutcliffe.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & Secd by Mr. Bulmer
That the time for the return of the Collectors
Roll, be extended to the 16th March 1895.

Carried.

On motion of Mr. Bulmer Secd by Mr.
Reynolds By Law No 113 was now
brought up and read a third time & passed.

Moved by Mr. Bulmer & Secd by Mr. McLaren
That the Clerk draw up and frame a petition
to be handed to the Respective Members of the
Federal and Local Governments, asking
that Grants be given for the building of an
interprovincial Bridge, between the Sp. of
Rosa in the Province of Ontario, and the
Calumet Island in the Prov. of Quebec
and that Copies of the said Petition.

Be left at the P.O. Forsters Falls, Leobden and
other places - Carried.

On motion of Mr Crozier Secd by Mr Reynolds
The Council now adjourned to meet again on the
second Saturday in May as a Court of Revision
and afterwards for the general business of the township.
