examine the 7th Con. Line from the Town
Line down to Lot No 3, and report probable
cost of repairs at next meeting of Council.
Carried.

that the Bill of Mr Purvis P. L. S. stand over
till next meeting of Council.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer & Sec'd by Mr Brozier
that Mr Marshall be granted the sum of two
dollars & fifty cents, to get plank to cover
drain opposite his place, Cobden.
Carried.

purchase Cedars for two Culverts on 5th
Con, opposite Lot 12, Sp. of Ross. Carried.
