this Municipality.

from Culvert up to foot of hill, not to exceed \$10,  
Carried.

Mr. Crozier gives notice, That he will introduce

Survey made by Mr. Beattie P.L.S. of the property  
of Mr. Samuel Dixon known as Manor Reserve into  
alluvial Lots.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & Seconded by Mr. McLaren, That the  
Road Commission be instructed to examine Road & give out job  
of digging ditch opposite lot 25, Cor. 5, not to exceed \$10,  
Carried.
