That Mr. John Gibeault school taxes be refunded
to Trustees of School Section No. 9.

Moved by Mr. Wharen & Secd by Mr. Palmer,
That the Township printing be done at the
Standard Office, Pembroke, as heretofore.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & Secd by Mr. Crozier,
That the Council do now adjourn to meet
again first Saturday in May, as a Court of
Revision, and afterwards for the general
business of the Township.
