

Town Hall, Cobden

2nd May 1896

The Municipal Council of the Township of
Doss met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the above
date as a Court of Revision.

The Reeve in the Chair. All the members
of the Court present, & took the oath of office.

Moved by Mr McLaren & Sec'd by Mr Bulmer
That this Court sustain the assessor in
his assessment of Mr J. M. Hill's Lot.

Carried
On motion of Mr Crozier Sec'd by Mr Reynolds
The Roll as now Revised was accepted, and
The Court adjourned.

The Council now opened their meeting
for the regular business of the Township.
The Reeve in the Chair, and all the members
present.

The minutes of previous meeting was now
read. And it was moved by Mr McLaren
and seconded by Mr Crozier That the
last minutes of Council be ^{approved} accepted with
the exception of that motion granting
Mr Oates the privilege of ditching along
the Queens Line, to Mr Pentecost's gully
as objection has been made to it.
In the meantime, Messrs Jamieson &
Bulmer, will examine the water way
and report at next meeting of Council.
Carried.

As Mr Leorn appeared before the Council stating
that he was going to drain across his Lot, and
that it would be necessary to put two Culverts across
the Province line and that the Clerk notify Mr Peter May
to open up his drain to take water from the Culverts.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & Secd by Mr. Reynolds.
That the Clerk purchase 4 new steel Road
Scrapers for the use of the Township.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & Secd by
Mr. McLaren. That the Clerk notify the
Clerk Road Commissioners to examine
and give out job of building Bridge
across Gruffs Creek on Cobden and
~~Porter~~ Roads also to examine
Mrs. Maxims Hill on moving line opposite
Lot 5 & 6. on 9th Con. and to meet
with Road Commr of Westmeath in
re of Road on Town line of Ross &
Westmeath opposite first Con. of Ross.
also examine Road from Mr. Reynolds Hill
to Brick Kiln. and report at next
meeting of Council 6th June 1896.

Carried.
On motion of Mr. Reeves. Secd by
Mr. Crozier the Council now adjourned
to Saturday 6th day of June. /96.
