

Town Hall, Colburn
6th June 1876

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township. Deputy Reeve in the Chair. Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed. Mr. Jamieson, the Reeve was found absent. The Deputy Reeve, and all the Councillors being present.

Moved by Mr. Brozier & second by Mr. Reynolds that the Municipal Council be allowed to do his Statute Labor on 9th Con. Carried.

(2) Mr. Brozier gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law for the payment of money.

(5) Moved by Mr. Crozier & second by Mr. Reynolds that By Law No. 124 for the payment of money, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

5 Moved by Mr. McWharen and second by Mr. Reynolds that By Law No. 124, be filled in as per resolution of Council & then brought up and read a second time. Carried.

(4) Moved by Mr. Reynolds & second by Mr. Brozier that the following bills & accounts be paid.

On motion of Mr. Reynolds seconded by
Mr. McHaren. by law 127 was now brought
up and read a third time short & passed. Carried

Moved by Mr. Brozier & Sec'd by Mr. Reynolds
that the Road Comm. have the bridge
repaired on Mill Creek. pt. Con. opposite
Lots 13 & 14. Carried

Moved by Mr. McHaren and
Sec'd by Mr. Brozier. that the Road Comm.
be instructed to get Cedars for 4 Culverts
from 5th to 8th Con. Carried

Moved by Mr. Brozier & Sec'd by Mr. Reynolds
the Council grant the sum of \$30.00 to
cut out & widen Road on Town line
of Ross & Horton. from Gibbon Corner
to Town line of Admaston providing
Horton Council makes a like grant.
& that the Commissioners of Ross to Co. operate
with Commissioners Horton. to give out job.
and expend money. Carried

Moved by Mr. McHaren & Sec'd by Mr. Brozier
that the motion passed at the March meeting
of Council allowing Mr. Dales to
dig ditch along Queen's line to Mr.
Runkens Gully, be rescinded, as objection
has been made by petition and by several
interested parties. Carried

Moved by Mr. Reynolds ^{no 4} & Secd by Mr. McHaren, That the Road Commissioners be instructed to give out job of pulling stumps on Proving line near Mr. A. Struthers to get stumps pulled on Proving line opposite Chas. McGintys and to gravel Crossley opposite Lot 20. in 4th Con. not to exceed \$25. and to give out job of fixing hill on Proving line opposite Lot 21. 8th Con. near Mr. McMay not to exceed the sum of \$8⁰⁰ and to get cedars for Culverts opposite Lot 18. 4th Con.

Carried.

Moved by Mr. Crozier & Secd by Mr. McHaren That the Council do adjourn to meet again on first Saturday in August at 10. o'clock A. M.
