

Forsters Falls 15th Aug. 1896

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Clerks Office Forsters Falls on the above date as a Special meeting. Called by the Reev.

The Reev in the Chair.
Mr Reynolds gave notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law to levy a Rate to meet the Current expenses of the Municipality, the County Rates, the amounts required by the Trustees of the several School Sections of this Township for School purposes. The amounts required by law under the School Act of the Prov. of Ont. for schools.

Moved by Mr Reynolds & Second by Mr McHaren. That By-law No. 129 for the purpose of levying & collecting a sufficient Rate on the dollar, on Rateable property in the Township to defray the necessary expenses of the same for the Current year, the amounts required by law under the Public School Act of Ontario. Also the amounts required by the trustees of the several schools for School purposes, be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr McHaren & Second by Mr Reynolds That By-law No. 129 have the blanks filled in as follows: For Township purposes 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ Mills on the dollar, For City Rates 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the dollar, Gen. fund for Schools under the Public School Act of Ont. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills, and then brought up and read a second time. Carried.

On motion of Mr. Reynolds Sec'd by Mr. McLaren by Law No. 129. was now brought up and read a third time & passed.
The Council now adjourned on motion of Mr. McLaren Sec'd by Mr. Reynolds, to meet again at next regular meeting 12th Sept. 1896.
