Moved by Mrs. Humphries & Secd by Mr. Coulter, that the Clerk notify those parties who are paying Hotel & shop license. To pay the same into the "Bank of Ottawa", Pembroke, as that is what the Law requires.

Moved by Mr. Crozier & seconded by Mrs. Coulter, that Mr. J. A. Solan, be allowed the sum of twenty $\frac{42}{100}$ dollars as a Rebate on taxes for the year 1893, and that the Clerk notify the Com. Secs to withdraw. v. h. Cobden.
