of the Council present.

Minutes of previous meeting read &  
Confirmed.

Moved by Mr. Humphries & Second by  
Mr. Reynolds That the Auditors Report be  
accepted.

Moved by Mr. Reynolds & Seconded  
by Mr. Humphries, That we leave the Consideration  
of the Treasurer's Bond ~~over~~ till next meeting  
of Council.

Moved by Mr. Humphries and  
seconded by Mr. Coulter, That the Hall  
be rented for a Ball, as petitioned for  
by Dr. Wain, Mr. Dunlop, David Humphries,  
and others.

Moved by Mr. Crozier & Seconded by  
Mr. Reynolds. That Messrs P. R. Pounds and  
John Burton, be paid \$3<sup>00</sup> each for  
auditing Town Books, also ~~that~~  
John McEginn be paid his Salary for  
assessing.

Mr. Humphries gives notice  
That he will at this present meeting of  
Council introduce a By Law for the  
Regulation of Statute Labor in the un-  
incorporated Village of Cobden.



Moved by Mr Humphries & Sec'd by Mr Beutter  
That By Law No 137 for the Commutation of  
Statute Labor in the unincorporated village  
of Cobden be now brought up and read a  
first time. Carried.

Moved by Mr Crozier & Sec'd by Mr  
Reynolds, That By Law No 137 be filled in  
with the name of John Burton, and then  
brought up and read a second time.

On Motion of Mr Humphries seconded by  
Mr Crozier, By Law No 137 was now brought  
up and read a third time that & passed.

Moved by Mr Reynolds & Sec'd by Mr Crozier  
That the Clerk notify the Road Com<sup>rs</sup>  
to have the Road from Coffeys Bridge to end  
of Mr Frelsands Land repaired. Carried.

Moved by Mr Reynolds & Sec'd by Mr Crozier, That  
the Clerk shall purchase 1/2 doz. Steel Road scrapers  
for the use of the Townships. Carried.

Moved by Mr Reynolds & Sec'd by Mr Humphries. That  
David Ross be appointed Postmaster in place of  
John Ross. who has resigned. Carried.

Moved by Mr Crozier & Sec'd by Mr  
Reynolds, That Mr Humphries be authorized  
to purchase suitable blinds for windows  
of Town Hall. and have the same put up.

On Motion of Mr Beutter seconded by Mr  
Humphries the Council now adjourned to the  
last Saturday in May to meet as a Court  
of Revision & afterwards for general business.
