Mr. DeLaney gives notice that he will at next meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to prohibit furious driving on the Public Highways. To prevent leading or driving of Horses or Cattle on Sidewalks, or other places set apart for pedestrians. To prevent Carriage Wagens, Sleighs or other vehicles of every description from being hauled or propelled upon the Sidewalks, or pathways set apart for the use of pedestrians. Also to prevent all kinds of machinery being left on streets in such a ~~manner as to~~ <sup>manner as to</sup> obstruct the public travel.
