said Road.

to expend \$15.00 Mr. Bruce to give 2 days
work with man & team free.
7. Repairs on Bridge Near Joseph Jeffery
to be done as cheaply as possible.
8. Repairs on Crossway. to the amount
of \$35.00 This includes covering stones
& leveling up. not to exceed the \$35.00
