Culvert on Gov. Road, at J. H. Reynolds rebuilt  
by day labor. carried.

Moved by Mr. Childers  
& 2d by Mr. Delaney. That the agreement  
made between Messrs. McWhorter & Coulter and  
Mr. Delaney, & the Council, re water way  
be accepted. carried.

Moved by Mr. Childers &  
2d by Mr. Crozier. That the Clerk be in-  
structed to notify the Rear of Stafford  
Township to have the "Curly McEwen Bridge" &  
other obstructions, on the Muskrat River,  
running through the said Twp. of Stafford, removed  
by 1<sup>st</sup> March. Otherwise the Council will be compelled

to take action to have the same removed.  
Carried.  
Moved by Mr. DeLaney & second by Mr. Elliott.  
That a copy of Report re obstructions  
on Muskogee River be forwarded to the  
Warden of the County and would re-  
quest that prompt action be taken as  
regards same, and that the Warden be further  
notified that a copy of same has been sent  
to the Rev. of Stafford with notice to have  
the said obstructions removed. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Childerhiser seconded by  
Mr. DeLaney, that John Burton be ap-  
pointed Collector at a salary of forty  
dollars, moved in commendation by  
Mr. J. J. Elliott & second by Mr. Crozier.  
That the present Collector Mr. J. J. Elliott  
be retained at a salary of \$50.  
The Rev. decided in favor of Mr. Elliott.

Moved by Mr. Crozier seconded by Mr. Elliott.  
That by Law 72164 be filled in as per re-  
solution of Council, & then brought up  
& read a second & third time, & carried.  
passed. On motion of Messrs DeLaney &  
Crozier the Council now adjourned  
to meet again on Second Saturday in  
December at 7 O'clock P. M.
