

Town Hall Colburn
7th April 1900

Moved by Mr. Childerhose and seconded by Mr. Coultter that By-law No 171 for the payment of moneys be now brought up and read a first time. — carried.

Moved by Mr. Childerhose & seconded by Mr. Coultter that the Auditors Report be adopted and that the Treasurer was justified in paying Judges Order in favor of the Clerk Mr. Gault. re expenses Court of Revision. — carried.

Mr. McLaren gives notice that he will at

hours of Closing certain kinds of Shops
mentioned therein.

On motion of Messrs Elliott & McHaren
By Law No 172. was now brought up and
read a second & third time short & passed.

Moved by Mr McHaren & second by Mr Coulter
that Mr Tom Murbek be re-employed as
operator of Road Machine at \$1.50 per day.
and that he have full control of man
and teams engaged under him with au-
thority to discharge any man refusing
to work to his satisfaction and have
foreman report his work as usual.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Coulter & second by Mr Elliott
that the Clerk be instructed to notify all parties
on Prov. line between Collier & Fort St. John
to have all stones, stumps & logs removed
that have been laid on side of road by their
work to be done on or before the 15th June
if not done the same will be removed by
Road Com. at their expense.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Coulter & second by Mr Elliott that
the Road Com. be instructed to have 100m line
between Ross & Brandy. opposite lots 10 & 11
repaired. Not over \$15.00 to be expended on same. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McHaren & Sec'd by Mr. Childhouse
That Mr. James Gilmer, be allowed for all
his Stated Labor, on Acc. him between Feb 10 & 11.
Carried.

Moved by Mr. Childhouse Sec'd by Mr. Elliott
That Mr. McHaren examine 4th Con. line
at Mr. Whalens Swamp, and ascertain the
amount required to drain same, and
report at next meeting of Council.
Carried.

On motion of Messrs Elliott & McHaren
Mr. Tho^s Elliott Salary of \$50.⁰⁰ + \$1.25 for postage
was recommended for payment.

Moved by Mr. Childhouse & Sec'd by Mr. Coulter
That By had No 141. be filled in as per resolution
of Council & then brought up and read
second & third time short & passed.
Carried.

On motion of Mr. Coulter Sec'd by Mr. Elliott
The Council now adjourned to meet again
on the 1st Saturday in June at the hour of
9. O'clock A. M. as a Court of Revision
and after the Court. for the general business
of the Township.
