

Town Hall, Colman

12th May 1900.

A Special meeting was called by the Revue which was held on the above date in the Town Hall, Colman to Consider the vaccination of the School Children. All the members of the ~~School Child~~ Council present, the Revue in the Chair.

It was moved by Mr Coultter & 2nd by Mr Elliott, That as per recommendation of the Local Board of Health, that this Council make it compulsory that all Children between the ages of 5 & 15 years attending School be vaccinated at the expense of the Municipality, and that an agreement be entered into with Dr. Main, Delaney & Wharen, for the due performance of the same, at the fee provided for by Statute. They to arrange among themselves as to the division of the work, and they will also notify the trustees of the several School Sections at the time that they will visit the Schools. Carried

Moved by Mrs Wharen & 2nd by Mrs Childers that Messrs Delaney & Coultter visit Mr J. H. Reynolds and see what arrangement they can make with him for a gravel pit near Gosstons Falls. Carried

On motion of Messrs Elliott & Wharen the Council now adjourns till their regular meeting 2nd June next.
