in ditch, on Road allowance in front of his farm by 20th
June. failing to do so the same will be removed at his expense. Carried.

That By Law No 143 be filed in as per Resolution
of Council and then brought up and read
a 2d & 3rd time & then passed.

amount to be expended.
5. Job on Town Lane Ross & Bromley, Opposite A. Conley's
6. Job of Bridge at Mrs McEays
7. Job of Bridge at Norman Kohnsmid. Prov. line
not to exceed \$30.00
8. To build dam on drain on Prov. line at
James McLaughlin's.
9. Job of Brushing out - ~~Town Lane~~ Gov. Road
from Duncan McLaren's to Town Lane of Norton.
10. Rep. Culvert - Town Lane Ross & Bromley, near
J. M. Jeffreys.
11. Bridges on Queens Lane Opposite Mrs Wallace's
12. Stamping 6th Con. near James McLaughlin.
