Moved by Mr Wharum & second by Mr Elliott That the Road Commission be instructed to give out the job of graveling the Gov. Road from Howard St. to Old Brick yard, as petitioned for by R. A. Williams, and others amount to be expended not to exceed \$50.<sup>00</sup>. Carried

Moved by Mr Childerhouse and second by Mr Elliott That James Gilmer, J. M. & James Ferguson be allowed two years Statute Labor, 1900 & 1901 for Labor done on ~~on~~ Prov. hain. Con. 4 & 5. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott & second by Mr Coulter That Mr. Robt. Reilly get the job of putting a railing on the Bridge near his place. Carried

On motion of Messrs Childerhouse & Elliott the Council now adjourned to meet again at 1. O'clock P. M.

Council resumed business at 1. O'clock P. M. again all members present

Mr Childerhose gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of raising by way of loan a certain sum of money to meet the Current-Expenses.

Moved by Mr Coulter & Secd by Mr Elliott That By-Law No 176. for the raising of a certain sum of money by way of a loan be now brought up and read a first time. Carried.
