

Town Hall, Cobden

13th October 1900

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross. met in the Town Hall, Cobden on the above date for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

All the members of the Council present
The Minutes of the previous meeting read & confirmed.

Mr. McLaren gives notice that he will introduce a By-Law, at this present meeting of Council for the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Mr. Childers gives notice that he will at next meeting of Council introduce a By-Law, for the purpose of closing up that portion of the Road used in place of Concession line opposite Lots 4 & 5. north of Con. 7. Sp. of Ross.

Mr. Coulter gives notice that he will at next meeting of Council introduce a By-Law for the purpose of closing up that portion of Road running from Gov. Road to Con. line, on Lot 9. Con. 8. Sp. of Ross.

Moved by Mr. Childers & second by Mr. Elliott, that R. J. Pever be employed to repair Road opposite his place & David Johnston. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Elliott & second by Mr. Coulter that Elmer Neil be instructed to repair Road at Coffey's Bridge. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & second by Mr. Childers that Messrs Elliott & Delaney, examine the Road opposite Dr. McIllopie, and have necessary Culverts put in by Road Commissioner. Carried.

Moved by Mr. McLaren & second by Mr. Elliott.
That Messrs. Coulter & Childerhouse, purchase Wheel
Road Scraper from Mr. Ingly, if in their opinion
it is good value for price asked. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Coulter & second by Mr. Childerhouse, That
The Road Commissioners, have the Road from Mr
McLeays to Town Line repaired, and also to repair
Hill at Brickyard. Carried.

The Council now adjourned to
meet again on the 1st Saturday in December.
