

Town Hall, Cobden

June 15, 1901.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall, Cobden, on the above date as a Court of Revision. All the members were present and took the oath of office required by law. The name in the Chair.

Moved by Messrs Curry and Bennett that the following names be added to the assessment roll, viz: -

Geo. McCaskill Jr and Andrew Jack as farmers sons; Wm Baird, Geo. Curry, Joseph Currie, Fred Hartman, Frank Hartman and John Lafurgy as wage earners. Carried.

As there were no other complaints handed in it was then moved by Messrs McLarin & Curry that the roll as now revised be accepted. Carried.

On motion of Messrs Bennett & Jeffery the Court now adjourned.

The Council then opened their meeting at 8 o'clock for the general business of the Township. All the members present, the name in the Chair.

Minutes of previous meeting were read.

opposite Lot. No. 4. Carried.

that By Law No 187 be now filled in
as per resolution of Council and

third times short and passed Carried.

Moved by Messrs McLaren & Bennett
that By Law No 187 for the purpose
of raising by way of loan a
certain sum of money be now
brought up and read a first time
Carried.

Jeffery By Law No 188 was now filled
