Moved by Messrs Curry and Bennett that By Law No 192. re. Levy be now introduced and read a first time. Carried.

The By Law was read a first time accordingly.

Moved by Messrs Curry and Jeffery that Mr J. D. McLann be instructed to put up notices re. giving out of job on job on line and give out same. Carried.

On Motion of Messrs Jeffery & McLann By Law No. 191 was now filed in as per resolution of Council and then put up and read a second and third time short and passed.

Moved by Messrs McLaren and Bennett  
that the Rure be instructed to lay out  
one days work for Road Machine from  
Tuffys Hill to Culvert in Bush at Lot 107.  
Carried.

Moved by Mr Jeffery sec. by Mr Bennett  
that Messrs L. Curry & J. O. McLaren see  
about the building of Bridge near Boltons  
and also Culvert on same road. Carried.

On Motion of Messrs Curry and Bennett  
By Law No 192 was now put up and  
read a second and third time  
and passed.

Moved by Messrs McLaren and Curry  
that a job be given out on Tuffys  
Hill as soon as possible and that  
the Councillors be authorized to look  
after all jobs till Road Commission's return  
Carried.

Council now adjourned till Saturday  
the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October at 10 O. Clock A.M.
