Mr Black that the Auditor's Report  
be accepted. Carried

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by Mr  
Jeffery that we adjourn till the next  
meeting. Carried

again resumed present as before.

Moved by Mr Bennett seconded by  
Mr Daly that the Collector's Roll be  
accepted as now completed. Carried.

Moved by Mr Watly seconded by Mr Jeffery that the Foresters Falls Road between the yard from the bridge at Mr Gadders to dividing line between Lots No. 3 & 4 in the 6th Con. Carried

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Bennett that the Road Commission be instructed as follows; -

- 1st. To purchase and have delivered, sufficient material for railing on bridge on Govt. Road at Lot No 4. con 6.
- 2nd. To give out job on 10 Con. opposite Lot No 12.
- 3rd To give out job of building culvert on 3rd Con. line opposite Mr Thos O'Brien's.
- 4th To give out job of covering bridge across creek opposite Lot No 20 on Gould's Line, 5th to inspect road between Lots No. 15 & 16. Con. 5 - and report at next meeting of Council the estimated cost of repairing same.
- 6th To examine culvert on same road and give out job on same.

The following changes were made in  
patrolmasters, namely:

Thos. Whalaw, Wm Payne & Henry Darrow  
in place of John Appleby, Wm Campbell  
and Alfred Power,

Mr Chas. Power stated that he exper-  
ienced difficulty last year with some  
of the men under his control owing to  
their being asked to perform their seasonal  
labor some distance from their homes  
He requested that this Road division  
be divided and another patrolmaster  
appointed.

It was moved by Mr Jeffrey, seconded  
by Mr Walby that the Road division  
over which Mr Power was appointed  
be divided and Mr Thos Matheson Jr  
be appointed patrolmaster over part of same  
Carried

Moved by Mr Jeffrey seconded by Mr Bennett  
that the Rive be authorized <sup>offer for</sup> to sell that  
portion of Proving Line lying between the N E's  
of Lots No 10 & 11 Contg 20 Acs, Carried.

A Motion of Mr Black sec. by Mr Bennett  
Bylaw No 20 was now filled in as per  
Resolution of council and then brought  
up and read a second and third time  
short and passed.

Moved by Mr Walby sec. by Mr Jeffrey that the  
Rive have the Road scraper repaired and  
ready for use as soon as possible.

Council now adjourned to meet again on the  
1st of June at 9 o'clock as a Court of Revision  
and to take the case for the general business of the Towne by
