

Town Hall Cobden,

7th June 1902.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled as a court of Revision at 10 O. Clock this forenoon. All the members were present except Mr Jeffery and took the oath required by law, the Reeve in the Chair.

As no complaints were made of errors or omissions in the Assessment Roll it was moved by Mr Haly seconded by Mr Black that the Roll be accepted as it stands and that the Court do now adjourn. Carried

The Council then opened its meeting at 11 O'Clock for the general business of the Township. All the members present except Mr Jeffery the Reeve in the Chair.

Mr Haly gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law to provide for the payment of moneys.

Moved by Mr Haly seconded by Mr Bennett that By-law No 202 for the payment of moneys be now introduced and read a first time. Carried

The By-law was read a first time.

Mr Black gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By-law relating to the Abatement of Nuisances in the Township of Ross.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Haly that By-law No 203 relating to the Abatement of Nuisances be now introduced and read a first time. Carried

The By-law was read a first time.

Moved by Mr Haly seconded by Mr Black that this Council grant \$12⁰⁰ to the village of Haly's to assist in grading streets and purchasing material for a sidewalk. Money to be placed ^{in Mr Haly's hands.} Carried

On motion of Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Black Council now adjourned till 1 O'Clock

Persuant to adjournment Council again

resumed, present as before.

Moved by Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Halsey that this Township provide the Road Scraper and one man to assist Colden in repairing road from Brickyard corner to Agricultural Hall. Carried

Moved by Mr Halsey seconded by Mr Bennett that Messrs Black and Bennett ^{Town Road Com,} be appointed a deputation from this council to meet the Council of Whitmeath re the giving out of a job on the Townland opposite Lot No 1 in the 2nd Con. Carried

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Halsey that the Engineer be brought on to decide the opening of a ditch across Lots No 12, 13 & 14 in the 1st Concession. Carried

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Bennett that a grant of \$20⁰⁰ be given to build a culvert and repair a road on 3rd Concession line opposite Mr Chas O'Brien's. Carried.

Moved by Mr Halsey seconded by Mr Black that \$8⁰⁰ be given to Michael Roach for the digging of a ditch along Lot No 9 Con 1. Carried.
