ledging the receipt of a resolution
passed by this Council at their
last meeting relating to a survey
of the 9th Con. Line from Lot No 1 to
Lot No 5 Inclusive, and from Mr P. P. P.
Pounder claiming a balance of \$2.00
and the Trustees of S. S. No. 6. for use of
School House as polling booth on May 29th.

Mr Childerhose stated that he had no report to submit regarding the meeting of the Co. Council at Ringrow on the 7th inst, as that meeting had been postponed till the 18th of November.

Mr Jeffery gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a By Law to provide for the payment of money

Moved by Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr Bennett that By Law No 208 for the payment of money be now introduced, and read a first time, Carried
The Bylaw was read a first time.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again assembled; present as before,
Moved by Mr Hally seconded by Mr Black that the Road Commissioners be

instructed as follows:—

1st To repair Bridge at Mr Stephen Byers. 2nd To Repair Bridge on Cobden Road opposite 4th Con. 3rd To put in Culvert on same road opposite Mr Wm Murdock's 4th to give out job of repairing bridge on road between Lots 10 & 11 Con 3 and 5th to Repair bridge at Wm Murdock's Gate. Carried

Mr Stephens as a representative of the Cobden Council appeared before this session for the purpose of arranging a settlement between the two councils regarding the Town Hall.

He proposed that Cobden be given the full use of the building for a period of ten years at the end of which time it would become the sole property of the Township of Ross.

Mr Black thought this inadvisable as it would deprive succeeding Councils from disposing of hall till the expiration of that period of time.

Mr Jeffery proposed buying out Cobden's share of the property which is \$62.50. A Motion to this effect was drawn up, moved by Mr Jeffery and seconded by Mr Hally,

Moved in amendment by Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Black that the agreement between the two parties remain as it at present exists.

The Motion carried, the Rules supporting it.

The purchasing of the Grand-pit at Goulter's Falls was then discussed.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Bennett

that this Council purchase one acre
of land from Mr Jno. H. Reynolds to
be used by the Township of Ross for
a Gravel Pit. Carried on a Division
For Messrs Black, Bennett and Halcy
Against - Mr Jeffery.

Moved by Mr Bennett seconded by
Mr Halcy that the clerk request Mr
Reynolds to meet the Council at their
next meeting for the purpose of arrange-
ment a settlement Carried

Moved by Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr
Black that Bylaw No 208 be now
filed in as per resolution of
Council and then bot up and
read a second and third time short
and passed. Carried.

The Bylaw was filed accordingly
and then read a second and third
time short and passed.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by
Mr Halcy that Mr Jeffery inform road
on 4th Con. Line opposite Lot 15 and give out
job of digging ditch along same if he considers
it necessary. cost not to exceed \$5⁰⁰ per acre
Carried

to meet again on the first Saturday
in December at 11 O'Clock A.M.
