

Town Hall, Cobden

6th Dec, 1902

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 11 O'clock for the general business of the Township.

Present: - All the members. The Reeve in the Chair.

An motion of Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr Haly minutes of former meeting were accepted as read, confirmed and signed by the Reeve.

Notices of this intention to introduce Bylaws ^{at present meeting of Council} were given as follows.

First To provide for the payment of Accounts by Mr Jeffery

second For the appointment of Clerks by Returning Officers for the three Polling Sub-divisions of the Township of Ross, by Mr Bennett.

Moved by Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr Haly that Bylaw No 209 to provide for the payment of Accounts be now introduced and read a first time. Carried

Moved by Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Black that Bylaw No 210. For the appointment of all P.C.'s for the three P.S.D.'s of the Twp of Ross be now introduced and read a first time. Carried

The Bylaws were read a first time.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Bennett that Jas Burton be refunded \$2.⁰⁰ for Statute Labor performed by him. Carried

An Motion of Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr Black Council adjourned till one O'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council
again assembled present as before
Moved by Mr Jeffery seconded by
Mr Black that Mr Jos. Jeffery be
paid \$21⁰⁰ for Building Curbs and
grading road opposite Lot 24 Con. St.
Carried

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by
Mr Black that Public Notice be given to
all persons having fences in the Township of
Ross which cause snow to lodge and
obstruct the public highway to have said
fences removed as the Municipal Council
will not hold themselves responsible for
and damage which may occur by reason
of the said blockade of snow.
Carried,

Moved by Mr Daly seconded by Mr Jeffery
that Mr Black be refunded \$4⁰⁰ for Labor
returned undone.
Carried

Moved by Mr Jeffery seconded by Mr Black
that the Reeve and the Clerk be empowered
to attach their names and the seal of
the Corporation to an agreement as
follows:-

This Indenture made this sixth day
of December 1902 between the Municipal
Corporation of the Township of Ross hereinafter
called the party of the first part and a
company of persons of the same Township whose
names are attached to this agreement, hereinafter
called the party of the second part,

Witnesseth that in consideration of
(\$50⁰⁰) fifty dollars of lawful money of
Canada paid by the party of the second part
to the party of the first part, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged the party of the

first part doth hereby agree to give to the party of the second part and their heirs full of charge the privilege of entering the gravel pit at Plover's Falls owned by the party of the first part and taking therefrom all the sand and gravel required by them for their own exclusive use.

Carried.

The above agreement was signed, sealed and delivered in the presence of Geo. McCaskey Sr.

Moved by Mr. Haley seconded by Mr. Bennett that the Clerk communicate with Mr. Geo. Jack re. the settlement for Statute Labor for S¹/₂ Lot No. 13. in the 9th con. Carried.
