

Town Hall, Cobden
April 4th, 1903.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross assembled this forenoon at 11 o'clock for the transaction of the general business of the Township.

Present - all the members except Mr Daley. The Reeve in the chair.

Minutes of former meeting were accepted as read, confirmed and signed by the Reeve.

A petition was presented to this Council by Mr J. J. Moxam, requesting that the 9th Con. line opposite lot no. 9 be opened up to the lawful width and also a petition from Mr Geo. Thrasher praying that this Council will so alter the boundaries of S.P. no. 5 that it will take in all the land on both sides of the Government road from McLaren's Post office to Jas. Mordys.

Mr Daley now presented himself at the Council. Mr Bulmer gives notice that he will at this present meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the payment of certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Black that Bylaw no. 214 for the payment of moneys be now introduced and read a first time. Carried.

The Bylaw was read a first time.

A motion of Mr Bennett seconded by Mr Daley Council now adjourned till 10 o'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment Council again resumed present as before.

A motion of Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Daley Messrs Black and Curry were appointed a deputation from this Council to wait on the Westmask Council at their next session with a view to obtaining from them if possible a grant of money to aid in repairing the Cobden Road from the 7th Con. line to Cobden.

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Daley that

Messrs Bennet and Bulmer be appointed by this Council
to interview the owners of all the land on the north side
of the road from Cobden to Forester's Falls to arrange
with them re. the building of a wire fence on that
side of the road. Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Haley that
the Road Commissioner be instructed as follows.

1st. To make an estimate of the cost of repairing road
between Jas Jefferys and Mr Cook's Dred. To inspect
disch on 4th Con. line at John Goulds. Carried

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Haley that
Mr Curry be authorized to interview a solicitor
re. the opening up of the 9th Con. line opposite Lot No. 9.
Carried.

Moved by Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Haley that
the following bills and accounts be paid and
orders granted on the Treasurer for same viz:

of Council and then brot up and read a second and
third time, short, and passed.

Moved by Mr Bennet seconded by Mr Black that this Council
assemble in the Orange Hall at Forester's Falls on the 15th inst.
for the purpose of enacting a By-law re. the changing of S. No. 6
as per petition presented to this Council at its present session. Carried.

A motion of Mr Bulmer seconded by Mr Black Council now
adjourned to meet on the last Saturday in May at 9 O'clock
as a court of Revision and after the court for the general business
of the Township.
